

APWEN HOLDS ITS STEM FOR ALL PROGRAMME IN UYO

The Association of Professional Women Engineers of Nigeria (APWEN) held a special South South STEM FOR ALL programme in the city of Uyo, Akwa Ibom State on Friday 14th November 2025. The theme for the event was “Promoting Inclusivity and Diversity in Engineering for a Sustainable World” and the Keynote speech was delivered by Engr. Dr. Iniobong L. Usoro, FNSE, FNICE.

The APWEN President; Engr. Dr. Adebisi Osim, FNSE in her welcome speech urged the participants to mentor students, advocate for diverse teams on their projects, and integrate sustainability into every blueprint, while noting that women in Nigeria make up just 17% of tech professionals and 22% of engineering and technology students in universities. This she said was a missed opportunity for innovation.

Dr Osim reminded participants that women engineers are at the forefront, reiterating that a diverse team designs better bridges, smarter grids, and cleaner tech.

The keynote speaker, Dr. Usoro thanked the Association of Professional Women Engineers of Nigeria for continuously shining the light on inclusivity and diversity, reminding everyone the progress the platform has provided for yearly invites to table of innovation.

She urged the mentors, teachers and leaders to keep opening doors for the young ones, while reiterating the need to continue to plant seeds of curiosity, nurture confidence, and celebrate small victories.

Dr. Usoro encouraged the students to be bold, curious and unstoppable, while stating the need to make STEM truly for all.
